Discussion:

- 1) Minutes of Nov 21, 2007 meeting approved with addition of future agenda items
- 2) School Bike Safety. Scott will announce city/district wide crossing guard appreciation day through the PTAs. Likely will be in February.
- 3) Goals for 2008:
  - Stevens Creek Trail Feasibility Study completed and approved by City Council
  - Initiate next step towards Stevens Creek Trail implementation, possibly defining a CIP for conceptual design.
  - Update ADA project priority list
  - Reassess and reinstate bike safety programs at local public schools
  - Continue community outreach, e.g., Bike to Work Day
- 4) Mountain View High School Parking: Scott presented notes from 11/28/07 Mountain View Council Transportation Committee hearing on MVHS parking. MV CTC voted 3-0 to recommend re-opening the school-side of Truman for parking during school hours. Full council will take up the issue on Feb 13, 2008.
- 5) Bike accident on Deodara at Arboretum. Item continued.
- 6) Stevens Creek Trail Task Force. Alta Design is preparing final draft and updating with staff's criteria. Staff will meet and discuss proposal with Sunnyvale and Cupertino counterparts. If BPAC members receive email from public, please forward it to staff (Lind) for consolidation and response. BPAC members should not respond individually.
- 7) Traffic Commission. In November, TC conducted a public hearing on a Safe Routes to School proposal to add a sidewalk between Egan Jr. High and Westminster along the south side of W. Portola Ave. Commission has two openings to fill. One commissioner declined to serve another term and one resigned in the fall.
- 8) VTA BPAC update: continued.
- 9) Future agenda items: 1, 2, 3, 4,5, 6, 7, 8; review ADA projects; CIP update
