

Public Sculpture Loan Program

The Public Outdoor Sculpture Loan Program is the primary focus of the Los Altos Public Arts Commission. Many of the sculptures that are part of the Public Sculpture program either are or were once loaned to the city by the artist.

Pieces are loaned to the city for a period of 2 years, and upon conclusion of the loan period are either reloaned by the artist for an additional 2 year period or removed. On occasion, the pieces are donated to the City by either the artist or a third party/ parties who purchase the piece for the city.
