

CITY OF LOS ALTOS PETITION FOR TRAFFIC Mitigation DATE SUBMITTED: 9 7 2010

We, the undersigned, are residents of properties bordering Carmel Terrace, Altamead Drive, Lammy Place, and Volti Lane.

The City of Los Altos has installed "No Stopping Signs" at, and near, the intersection of Altamead and Carmel Terrace. This calming measure was in response to a previous petition submitted by this same neighborhood on May 3, 2007, with the concern that the traffic had become unacceptably congested and unsafe during before school hours. 70-75 Blach parents were dropping off students at the Carmel Terrace/Altamead intersection between the hours of 7:45-8:10 AM, blocking traffic and creating an unsafe environment for the 100+ pedestrians and bicyclists also using these same streets. Approximately, 100% of the Miramonte School parents use these streets to drop off their students. This created a high volume of traffic, in the immediate and adjoining streets, for which the streets were not designed. Since the installation of the "No Stopping" signs, the traffic on these back streets have become a safer environment for all residents and commuting students.

We hereby request that the City of Los Altos leave the "No Stopping" signs in place and extend this experiment until December, 2012, at which time they will reevaluate the
