

Senior Neighborhood Service Facility**Mission:**

To celebrate and cultivate community by extending senior services to residents in South Los Altos.

Proposal:

Allocation of one classroom at Grant Park to be used as a Senior/Neighborhood Services Room. We believe a pilot program of one day a week (recommend Tuesday) for 4 hours (10:00am - 2:00pm) would be a great programmatic start.

The room will be utilized as a venue for Senior who would like the opportunity to socialize and interact with fellow community members nearby and who are unable to seek transportation to the Hillview location.

The seniors are looking forward to a south city location. Few of the neighborhood community leaders have voiced their willingness to volunteer and supervise the room or lead discussion groups or a club.

The ideas that they have developed are endless. Some of the few ideas are:

- 1. Book clubs and discussion group**
- 2. Garden club**
- 3. Organizing visitations to other seniors in the community who are immobile.**
- 4. Community Services - collecting items to benefit those in need. (E.g. - collecting blankets and sundries for other communities who have suffered a disaster)**

The Seniors would be glad to share the use of the room to house and provide a storage location for the emergency preparedness equipment and supplies needed for South Los Altos. We recognize that it may be beneficial to be able to have quick access to supplies should there be a major disaster in South Los Altos.

Having a classroom at the Grant Park facility would also be beneficial to the city. Grant Park has suffered multiple incidences of vandalism. Having a room allocated as a Senior/Neighborhood Services room would allow space for local law enforcement officers to check in with neighbors, sit and organize their reports, and increase the oversight of our local recreation center.
